☐ A. Getting on Track for College (for 9th or 10th graders) – maximum of five hours)

Includes the following:

- Administration of self-assessment tools (re: learning style, personality, preferences, etc.)
- Review of academic program/performance, interests, strengths, activities, etc.
- Advice on course selection
- Review of/recommendations for extra-curricular and summer activities
- Review of testing requirements, options, and timelines
- Advice on maximizing high school experience as preparation for building/enhancing application profile

□ B. College Planning Package (for 10th, 11th or 12th graders – maximum of 10 hours) *

Includes the following:

- Administration of self-assessment surveys regarding learning style, personality, preferences, etc.
- Discussion with student and parent(s) about college search restrictions, concerns, issues, goals, etc.
- Intro to "affordability" and financial aid process, including how to calculate Expected Family Contribution (EFC)
- Review of academic program/performance and advice on development of authentic "standout" factor(s)
- Advice on developing key relationships (e.g., school personnel/recommenders, admission officers, et. al.)
- Preparation of a select, carefully curated list of potential college matches specifically suited to the student
- 24/7 access to GuidedPath online management tool through the duration of the consultation

☐ C. Comprehensive Package (for 10th, 11th or 12th graders – maximum of 20 hours) *

Includes all services in College Planning Package B (above) PLUS the following:

- Organizational timeline for completion of tasks
- Common or Coalition Application (or institutional) essay brain-storming session
- Review/critique of one Common or Coalition Application (or institutional) essay (through completion)
- Review/critique of up to five additional supplementary essays (through completion)
- Interviewing practice session
- Ongoing development/review of activities list and "stand-out" factor(s)
- Final review of up to 12 Common or Coalition Applications (or institution-generated applications) and collegespecific questions
- Assistance with making final college choice (including review of financial aid packages)

☐ D. Transfer Package (for post-graduate students – maximum of 10 hours)

Includes applicable services in C. (above), with a focus on the student's specific needs
